The kitchen was configured in an L-shape to make the most of the limited space; the Shaker-style cabinets extend to the ceiling for maximum storage. Glass shelves accented with halogen potlights add to the open feeling. The grey veining in the Carrara marble countertops and backsplash is almost the same hue as the cabinetry. Counters, backsplash fabricated by Contour Marble & Granite; faucet, Taps; window, Authentic Windows & Doors; painting by Nancy Kembrly; Art Interiors; scale, Teatro Verde; bottles, Senses; mortar, pestle, Fox Run Craftsmen; white tureen, Angus & Company; silver vases, Restoration Hardware.



Marta and Massimo had their rosewood dining table refinished, rather than replacing it, because they loved its shape. The wainscoting was painted a lighter version of the kitchen cabinet colour. A radiator, removed along with a window to allow for the french doors, was repositioned in the island and painted black to make it less visible.
